 - A visual daily timetable/schedule.
 - Clear labelling (image or photograph) of student resources in areas or on shelves.
 - Visuals to support expectations on the mat.
 - Clearly defined work areas.
- Regulation space (Zen Den set up).
- Creating a growth mindset.
- Using process praise.
